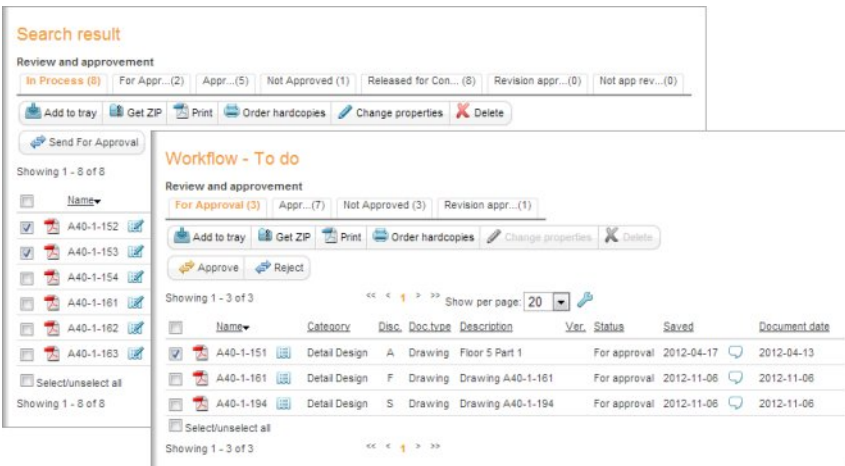
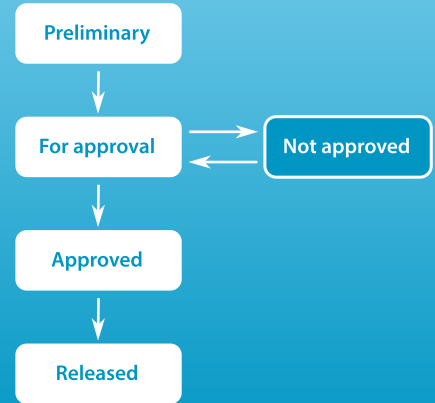

Files are guided through predefined stages where the document status and the read/write permission settings can be controlled. For example you can set the read permission so that documents may not be seen by project participants until they have been approved. Status and permission settings can be tailored to your specific review process requirements.
